

the HQK jazz jam session rules

Musicians and Jazz fans \$5, students \$2

(this supports the lights, heat, advertising, and insurance as well as the house group)

- · the house group will open each set with one tune of their choice
- musicians only play two tunes at a time, then take a seat and listen
- · singers (if any) only sing one tune at a time, then take a seat and listen
- choose tunes everyone on the stand knows
- · learn some tunes that you love, and do them
- · make sure you are in tune with everyone on the stand
- never cut off another soloist while they're playing
- · don't be a solo hog. say what you have to say in as few choruses as possible
- · don't play (even softly) while someone else is soloing
- keep your volume reasonable (especially guitarists)
- keep tempos reasonable for everyone on the stand
- · the house trio does not need to solo on every tune
- remember the solo order so when fours come up, everybody gets a turn
- remember it's a supportive and collaborative atmosphere not a competition
- · don't call tunes no one knows to try and impress everyone
- · don't judge other people's tunes, if you don't like a tune, sit that one out
- · don't criticize anyone on the stand-on the break make a kind suggestion to them
- always respect the other musicians
